The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Liberia, His Honor Francis S. Korkpor, Sr. has directed that all Circuit Courts across Liberia open their quarterly sessions for the February, A.D. 2018 Term of Court, on Tuesday, February 13, 2018.


Chief Justice Korkpor, in a memorandum to Circuit Judges throughout the Republic of Liberia, said the decision to open courts on Tuesday, February 13, 2018 is due to the observance of Armed Forces Day which falls on Sunday, February 11, 2018 and will be officially celebrated on Monday, February 12, which incidentally is the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of February on which Circuit Courts are to open their quarterly session, as a national holiday.

According to a judicial release, Liberia's New Judiciary Law at Section 3.8 provides that all Circuit Courts except the 6<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit (Civil Law), shall open their quarterly sessions on the Second Monday in February, May, August and November each year.

The 6<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Civil Law Court, opens its quarterly terms on the third Monday in March, June, September and December each year.

Opening ceremonies in Montserrado County will take place at the 1<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit, Criminal Court "A" Temple of Justice on Capitol Hill, Monrovia.

Similar opening ceremonies will take place in the other 14 political subdivisions of the Country.
