Having carefully examined the records, and listened to the arguments on both sides and considered the evidence and the laws relevant thereto, it is hereby

ADJUDGED:

That the doctrine of *vis majeure* is inapplicable to the respondents/appellants as adequate remedies at law were available to the respondents/appellants to ensure the perfection of the appeal, including filing an application for the enlargement of the statutory period for perfecting the appeal.

Accordingly, the motion to dismiss the appeal is hereby granted, and the appeal dismissed. The Clerk of this Court is ordered to send a mandate to the trial court to resume jurisdiction over the case and enforce its judgment. Costs are ruled against the respondents/appellants. It is hereby so ordered.
