Having reviewed the facts and circumstances of this case, listened to the arguments advanced by counsels representing the parties, and in due consideration of the laws applicable, it is hereby

ADJUDGED:

That the appellant/plaintiff presented preponderance of the evidence in proof of his title. The appellees/defendants named in the cause, not having appeared to contest the appellant/plaintiff's right to possession of the property, the judgment of the lower court dismissing appellant/plaintiff's action, is hereby reversed.

That for the wrongful withholding of appellant/plaintiff's property for about two (2) years, and accruing benefits therefrom, appellant/plaintiff is entitled to damages.

Accordingly, we have determined that the appellees/defendants pay to the appellant/plaintiff the amount of Seventy Five Thousand United States dollars (USD\$75,000.00).
