


JUDGMENT

When the case was called for hearing, *Counsellor Stephen B. Dunbar* of the Dunbar and Dunbar Law Offices appeared for the movant/appellee. *Counsellor G. Alfred Sayeh* of the Law Offices of Sayeh and Sayeh appeared for the respondents/appellants.

Having listened to the arguments and contentions advanced by the parties, reviewed the facts and circumstances presented in the records, and examined the laws controlling in the case; and being satisfied that the respondents/appellants failed to meet the requirements of the law for the perfection of an appeal, without which the Supreme Court lacks the required jurisdiction to probe into the merits of the appeal, it is hereby

ADJUDGED:

That the motion to dismiss the appeal, being sound in law and in conformity with the many decisions of this Court, the same is hereby granted. Accordingly, the appeal taken by the

appellants/respondents from the judgment of the lower court to the Honourable Supreme Court is dismissed.

The Clerk of this Court is ordered to send a Mandate to the lower ordering the judge presiding therein to resume jurisdiction over the case and proceed to enforce the judgment of this Court in accordance with law. Costs are adjudged against the appellants/respondents. AND IT IS HEREBY SO ORDERED.
